Aroma: Bold aromas of black cherries, blue berries, rosemary, vanilla and spices.

Taste: Intense, deep concentration of red and dark berries, enlivened by high-

altitude acidity.

Food: Pairs well with steak, braised lamb shank, stew, and venison.

 $2018 \sim 95$  Points. "The super intense 2018 Altura Máxima Malbec has notes of black olives, soy sauce, decayed violets, ripe fruit and exotic spices and woods, and it feels very different from the rest of the range. This is an exceptional wine from one of the highest commercial vineyards in the world, reaching 3,111 meters above sea level. The palate is full-bodied, and the wine is very intense and ripe at 14.5% alcohol. In 2018, they harvested earlier, the equivalent to the 1st of October in the Northern Hemisphere. It's full-bodied, round, large, concentrated and powerful, exceptional and different." - Robert Parker's Wine Advocate, Nov/2022

 $2018 \sim 95$  Points. "The grapes for this Malbec made by Thibaut Delmotte were grown at 3,100m in Payogasta, which accounts for its extreme, exotic character. The wine was aged 24 months in oak to tame its natural vigour. Sharp acidity provides balance, while the complex nose delivers cherry, ripe plum, Greek olives, lavender, thyme and sage. It's opulent with vivid freshness and polished tannins, making for a truly pleasurable experience." - Decanter, Aug/2023

 $2018 \sim 94$  Points. "The 2018 Malbec Altura Maxima is made with grapes from a vineyard planted at a height of 3100 feet in Payogasta, Calchaquí Valley and was aged for 24 months. A high altitude red, it presents a ripe, balsamic nose with notes of redcurrant and hints of bay leaf, plum jam and chutney. In the mouth, it's sheer intensity and juice with heightened freshness and finely grained tannins that underline the lengthy palate which delivers good grip and flavor. A wine of excellent aging potential and longevity." - Antonio Galloni's Vinous, Nov/2021

 $2018 \sim 93$  Points. "A medium-to full-bodied red with perfumed aromas of violets, rose hips, brambleberries, cassis and rock salt. Concentrated, yet fresh with firm, finely knit tannins and tight layers of wild flowers and dark berries. Try from 2023." - James Suckling, May/2021

## OTHER INFO

With the Andes as the backdrop and close to the borders of Bolivia and Chile, the Salta region of Argentina is less accessible than better known wine regions in the country; some have called the area impenetrable. The true expression of terroir in this Malbec comes from the extreme altitude at which the vineyard sits, it receives much more sun, much less UV protection, producing thicker skinned grapes that deliver a more robust mouthfeel supported by fresh acidity. Since 2005, Winemaker Thibaut Delmotte has crafted wines of distinction and international acclaim for Bodega Colome while staying true to his French origins.
