Every family in Abruzzo has its own 'tatone'. A familiar and affectionate nickname for grandfather, 'tatone' is actually a fundamental figure in the traditional family hierarchy, whose age and maturity confer authority, prestige and wisdom.

Our Tatone is so: a mature and complex Montepulciano d'Abruzzo wine that is refined – 24 months in large Slavonian oak barrels and then 3 months in the bottle – to give it balance and elegance. It has aromas of fruit and spices and an excellent structure, accompanied by a lingering finish.
